



CAIRO'S SIGHTSEEING

The Palace of Baron Empain

Built by the Belgian-born industrialist, Baron-General Eduard Louis Joseph Empain, the palace represents the most popular landmarks of Heliopolis.

The River Nile

Considered by many people as the most famous river in history, along its banks, one of the oldest civilizations in mankind has been established. A Nile cruise in a Feluka can be very inspiring.

Pyramids & Sphinx

As an engineering miracle, the Pyramids stand stoutly for over 4500 years. Originally built by Kings Khufu, Khafre and Menkaure to be a burial places for the ruling Pharos during the Old & Middle Kingdoms. Today, the Pyramids are the only wonder surviving from the Seven Wonders of the World.

Azhar Park

Among several honors, this park is listed as one of the world's sixty great public spaces; enjoy exotic settings, reminiscent of ancient times gone by a variety of unique cafes and restaurants thoughtfully positioned for visitors to appreciate the most dramatic views of Cairo.

Citadel - Mohamed Ali Mosque

The Citadel was built by Salah El Din Al Ayoubbi, the Citadel incorporates the great mosque of Mohamed Ali, the architectural icon; Al Madrasa (School) of Sultan Hasan, and the Police and Military Museum. The area still enjoys a pure air and nice weather.

Egyptian Museum

Opened in 1902, the museum is often referred to as one of the most important museums in the world, with over 100,000 exhibits in 107 halls and galleries, in addition to the world's finest ancient Egyptian relics.

Wadi Degla Desert Conservation Area

As an engineering miracle, the Pyramids stand stoutly for over 4500 Located at the northern area of the Eastern Desert, sThe whole area is 60 km², and was declared a Natural Protectorate in 1999. On both sides of the area, caves were created that provide shelters and home for wildlife.

Khan El Khalili

Khan el-Khalili, a unique blend of bazaars that is now usually called 'El Khan', named for the great Caravansary. Together with Al-Muski market to the west, they comprise one of Cairo's most important oriental shopping areas.

El Khayamiya






